




ANOTHER FEATHER IN THE CAP OF MANAV RACHNA EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS





This was followed by demonstration of 3D obturation techniques- Backfill Downpack provided by Modi Surgicals. Participants attempted the same on their extracted tooth models.

The next session was headed by Dr. Ajay Logani (ex. President, ISDT) where he demonstrated the use of collagen plug for the management of open apex followed by placement of MTA plug. The procedure was then performed by the participants. The hands-on session concluded with demonstration on the much awaited retrieval of separated instruments by Dr. Vivek Hedge (President, IES). Sir introduced everyone to the application of BTR System for instrument retrieval. All participants used the system and attempted at removing the separated instruments. Throughout the workshop, we were supported by labomed, Zumax, CJ Opticals and Medentis Global who provided us with the microscopes. 20 microscopes were installed, out of which two clinical microscopes were set up for demonstrations. Participants were provided with 3D googles to view the same. A trade fair was also organized by Mani, Modi Surgicals, Medentis Global, Ergonoptix and Zumax.

The Modi Surgical team represented by Gaurav Modi and Dr. Charu along with Biraj from Cirkamed provided valuable support for the 3D Obturation and broken instrument retrieval exercises. Sound of Silence: Manay Rachna Meditates



First Law & Technology National Moot Court Competition at School of Law, Manay Rachna University




WORKSHOP ON POCSO ACT AND GOOD TOUCH & BAD TOUCH
